After the minutes of the last annual meeting had been confirmed, the Annual Report of the Council and the Treasurer's accounts were read, passed, and ordered to be printed in the March Journal. The election of officers for the ensuing year then took place, when Mr. S. Percy Smith was re-elected President, and Messrs. Corkill and Newman (who had by the rules been ballotted out) were also re-elected members of the Council, and the latter re-elected Hon. Treasurer. Mr. W. D. Webster was re-elected Hon. Auditor. The meeting then elected Mr. Edward Tregear an Hon. Member of the Society in recognition of his contributions towards Polynesian History, Traditions, and Philology, and also for his services as one of its first secretaries. Rule No. 3 was then altered to read, The Society shall consist of one (or more) patrons...
