This autobiographical sketch by Dean Jones, Professor of Medicine and Biochemistry at Emory University School of Medicine in Atlanta, USA, was prepared in celebration of his 64th birthday. The book chronicles life as a child of the cold war, a student of the Vietnam War and an adult with the blessings and challenges of family life and science. The book is organized into four parts highlighting 32 original poems, 32 of his favorite personal photographs, 32 of his original scientific papers, and 32 original oil paintings. Accompanying notes provide context and motivation. In Part 1, An Egg is a Gamble Encased in a Shell, he shares poems written as an inconsistent diary of youth and young adulthood. These reveal strong influences of contemporary events of the cold war, civil rights and the Vietnam War on development of philosophy of life. His father taught him, If you cannot see both sides of an argument, you are wearing blinders. He was functionally blind until 10 years old; healthcare was not universal, and there was no routine vision testing in small town America in the...
